The American Academy of Veterinary Acupuncture (AAVA) is pleased to announce its 2022 Annual Meeting taking place on April 8-10, in Memphis, Tennessee.

This AAVA event will be held at The Peabody Hotel. The Peabody Memphis offers a magnificent bridge between the "Blues City's" celebrated past and cosmopolitan present. The Peabody Memphis is located in the heart of downtown, just 15 minutes from Memphis International Airport (MEM) and blocks from the Memphis Rock 'n' Soul Museum, the Gibson Guitar Factory, Fed-Ex Forum and the Memphis Cook Convention Center. The Peabody is also one of few luxury hotels near Beale Street that offers topnotch transportation and parking services.

We are pleased to invite clinicians and other professionals to submit abstracts of a presentation for our 2022 meeting. **Submission of a paper represents a commitment to present this paper at the meeting if it is selected.** Papers selected will be presented by the Author and printed in the 2022 Proceedings Book of the event.

Acupuncture, acupuncture related and East-Asian medical therapy articles will be considered, including Chinese herbal medicine, food therapy, laser and Chinese Tui-Na therapies. We will be having round table discussions on interesting or unusual cases. We are accepting small and large animal case reports that our panel can present and discuss with the group.

Abstracts must be typewritten in English, double-spaced and should not exceed a single page of 8.5" x 11" paper (A4) with 1" margins (2.5 cm). Please format the abstract in a Microsoft Word document and send it as an attached document identified as "2022 AAVA ABSTRACT" in the email subject line.

Curriculum Vitae for each author must accompany the abstract. Abstracts submitted without this information will not be considered.

The deadline for submission is September 2, 2021.

Notification of acceptance will be sent by September 16, 2021 to those whose abstracts are selected by the AAVA Conference Committee for presentation at the meeting. The deadline for submission of the full article for the Proceedings Book will be November 15, 2021.

Keynote Lecturers (lectures of 4 hours or more) will receive honoraria and travel expenses up to \$500.00. Primary authors of selected papers of less than 4 hours of lecture will receive an hourly honoraria rate. Wet lab instructors will also receive an hourly honoraria rate. The hourly honoraria rate is \$250 per hour.
